NOTE: This is a twice a year inspection only. If your unit fails during this agreement period you will be charged for a service call to repair your unit, however, you will receive a 10% discount on both labor and materials.

AIR CONDITIONING 15 POINT PRECISION TUNE UP

- 1. Install gauges and check operating pressures
- 2. Check all voltage and amperage to all motors with meter
- 3. Check air temperature drop across evaporator
- 4. Check refrigerant charge
- 5. Lubricate all moving parts
- 6. Check belt and adjust tension
- 7. Replace or wash air filters as required
- 8. Check pressure switch cut out settings
- 9. Check electrical lock out circuits
- 10. Check starting contactor contacts
- 11. Check all wiring and connections
- 12. Clean and adjust thermostat
- 13. Check air temperature across condenser
- 14. Check that condensation drain is open
- 15. Inspect and clean (extra charge) condenser coils

- 1. Check safety controls
- 2. Check fan controls
- 3. Check thermostat operation
- 4. Check heat exchanger
- 5. Check and adjust fan belt
- 6. Check limit control

- 9. Check/install air filter

- 12. Check heat relays
- 13. Check amps of electric heat elements
- 14. Check refrigerant pressures (heat pumps)
